

It is a phenomenon that mainly affects pre-teens and teens. It has increased during the pandemic because virtual life sometimes replaced genuine relationships. The spread of the term vamping on the web seems to refer to 2014, when a New York Times article investigated the characteristics of this trend, presenting users who have this type of online habit as "social media vampires".
